This award-winning program brings the San Diego County Library to you! All qualifying County residents can receive library materials through the mail, free of charge, without having to leave home.

## You can receive services if you:

- Are temporarily or permanently homebound.
- Have a disability or are ill, or you're the caregiver for someone who is.
- Lack transportation or live in a remote area of San Diego County that is far from a library or mobile library stop.
