
LIBRARY HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAM TIMELINE



| Step | Estimated time | What to expect |
|--------------------------|-------------------|---|
| Self-Assessment | 20 minutes | Submit a self-assessment at LibraryHighSchool.org to tell us you are interested. |
| Welcome Email + Call | 3-5 days | You will receive a welcome email with your library card number and a link to enroll in Part 1 within 3-5 business days of submitting your self-assessment. We will also call you to talk about any questions you might have. |
| Prerequisite Part 1 | 15 days | Part 1 is your first prerequisite course. A prerequisite is something you are required to complete before enrolling in a full program to help you determine if you will be successful. You have 15 days to complete this course. If you do not complete it within 15 days, you can take the class again starting over from the beginning. |
| Orientation | 7 days | Once you complete Part 1, we will invite you to an orientation. You can choose whether you want to do your orientation over the phone or in person at a local library branch. It may take up to 7 days to schedule your orientation with a Library High School branch ambassador. |
| Prerequisite Part 2 Open | 1-2 days | During your orientation you will enroll in Part 2. It may take 1-2 days for the course to be unlocked. |
| Prerequisite Part 2 | 30 days | Part 2 is the second prerequisite period where you complete two courses within 30 days. During this time you will also be given an Academic Coach from the school district. |
| Full Scholarship | 3-18 months | Once you successfully complete Part 2, you are awarded the full scholarship. You will have up to 18 months to complete the rest of your coursework. Students are expected to complete 2 classes per month, but you set your own pace! Students can substantially reduce the amount of time this takes by transferring in previously earned credits. |
| Graduation | | SDCL hosts an annual graduation ceremony each summer! Once you graduate, we will invite you and your family to attend the graduation ceremony to celebrate your achievement! |
